9	ELIGIBILITY	The 2017 ITTF-Asian YOG Qualification Tournament is open to players born in 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003, of the National Associations (NAs) that are affiliated to the Asian Table Tennis Union, and are affiliated to their National Olympic Committee (NOC). Only entries of the athletes endorsed by their NA will be accepted. Each NA may enter one boy and one girl if no other player of the same gender from the same NOC are already qualified or in the process of confirmation through any previous qualification steps.
10	RULES AND REGULATIONS	The tournament shall be played in accordance with the Laws of Table Tennis and the ITTF Regulations for International Competitions.

<p>11 FORMAT OF PLAY</p>	<p>Four boys and four girls will qualify from this competition for the Buenos Aires 2018 Youth Olympic Games</p> <p>There will be two stages of round robin system, except matches for reserves places. All matches will be played the best of 7 games</p> <p>STAGE ONE</p> <p>CASE 1 If there are less than 18 entries, they will be play in 4 groups (1 to 4) of 3 to 5 players. The top three players will progress to play in stage 2 of the event.</p> <p>CASE 2 If there are 18 to 24 entries, they will be play in 6 groups (1 to 6) of 3 to 4 players. The top two players will progress to play in stage 2 of the event.</p> <p>CASE 3 If there are 25 to 35 entries, they will be play in 8 groups (1 to 8) of 3 to 5 players. The top two players will progress to play in stage 2 of the event.</p> <p>CASE 4 If there are 36 or more entries, they will be play in 12 groups (1 to 12) of 3 to 4 players. The top one player will progress to play in stage 2 of the event.</p> <p>STAGE TWO</p> <p>Twelve (cases 1, 2 and 4) or sixteen (case 3) players from Stage one will qualify for Stage two of the event.</p> <p>Players shall be drawn into four separate groups (A, B, C and D) of 3 to 4 players, according to the October 2017 ITTF World Junior Ranking. Players from the same group in Stage one shall be drawn into different draws in Stage 2.</p> <p>Winners of each group (4 in total) will qualify for YOG. Second positions of each group will be drawn to play three direct knock-out matches to determine the four reserves places for YOG.</p>

The ITTF Equipment Committee strongly recommends to all players to make certain that new racket coverings (rubbers) are aired 72 hours before use.
